

Capitelles Blanc Concentrated yet delicate

AOP Costières de Nîmes

Built with time and patience, a "Capitelle" is an ancient stone shack in the vineyard where the winemaker keeps his tools and takes shelter when storms are brewing. Vestige of a millenial tradition, it is also a distinctive landmark in our terroir.



The cut stone capitelle, which stands by our old vines, has inspired this exceptional cuvee as we would like our wines to be as long-lasting as the Capitelle itself and just like its stones we would like it both smooth and sharp.

Made with the very same « Beaucaire » stone, our cellar shelters and our barrels allow our cuvee Les Capitelles to age gracefully in a cool environment.

Blend

Mostly stemming from our oldest vines of Grenache blanc that grow over a patch of limestone, this wine shows a very distinct minerality that ensures its recognizable finish.

Mostly old vines of White Grenache completed with Rousanne and Viognier.

Pressed in full clusters, the wine is fermented and aged in 500-liter casks for 12 months.



Brilliant golden colour

Bouquet

White flower, dried fruits, almonds, light citrus and pit-fruits notes.

Palate

Beautiful silky structure after an opulent attack, where the concentration of aromas leads to a precise, mineral finish

Food Pairing

Perfect with poultry or veal, this wine's minerality will create a great balance with rich sauce dishes, whereas its profuse aromas will pair very well with wild mushrooms or noble fishes.
